Our spotlight this month is a long term Amherstburg resident LEE DENEAU. Many will remember Lee as the owner of Wigle Hardware on the corner of Sandwich and Richmond Street. The store has a rich history and first opened in the late 1800's. Lee began working in the store at age 16 and eventually bought the business and ran it until his retirement, a span of 54 years!
